

Queen Palm SPECIALS

Syagrus romansoffiana

1.4m PB18 - Normally \$35 - NOW \$18 OR 5 for \$75

1.6m 35L - Normally \$180 - NOW \$65 or 5 for \$300

Native to South America and is the most southerly growing palm on that continent. It is tall, with a solid, single trunk and a large head of long, feathery leaves. Suiting mild temperate to tropical climates, it prefers an open, sunny situation and tolerates some frost.

- Can grow in nontropical regions. Hardy to cold.
- Under ideal conditions, the species is one of the fastest-growing palms
- In NZ, approximately 5m after about 10 years.
- 15m in habitat but up to 23m in cultivation.
- The trunk diameter - in wetter more tropical areas exhibits thinner stems (20cm) vs drier, less tropical areas manifest thicker trunks 45-50cm.
- In general, old dead leaves do not last long on the palm. Technically not a self-cleaning palm so you may need a chain saw on a pole once established.
- Their marble-like seeds can be a health and safety issue if you step and slide on them!
- Amazing sculptural seed pods.
